Registered under (2) F & 12 (B) of the UGC Act and affiliated to the Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University this college was assessed and accredited "B+" Grade by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2007, which bears testimony to its academic status in the changing scenario in the sphere of higher education. In 2016 the college was re-assessed and re-accredited with "B" grade by NAAC. Since its inception this College promises to mete out quality education to its learners and render extension service to the people of the locality through NSS, NCC and various academic projects and activities. The College is located at a spacious campus, surrounded and protected by a boundary wall at Tufanganj Newtown, twenty five kilometers away from Cooch Behar town. Situated in the calm, green and serene lap of nature, it offers an ideal environment for learning and developing personality as well. Presently housed in three main building, it offers courses in Arts, Commerce and Science, all running simultaneously at day time. The medium of teaching is Bengali / English. The College has five staff quarters, one teachers' mess, a Girls' Hostel, presently used by Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalaya, a pond and two playgrounds fluttering over 14 acres of land.

### **Brief History of College:**

The foundation stone of Tufanganj College was laid on 26th March 1969 by the then District Magistrate of Cooch Behar and the name of the college was Tufanganj College and Institute of Agriculture. Later, on 29.11.70 the Institute of Agriculture was taken over by the Govt. of West Bengal and started Farmers' Training Centre. On 02.11.71. the College was renamed as Tufanganj College in a meeting of the College Committee. Further, the aforesaid Committee in its meeting on 17.11.71. decided to start the College from 1971-'72 academic session in anticipation of the Government's approval, with the Principal, seven lecturers, one clerk, two peons, one night guard and one sweeper. The College was

inaugurated on 23.12.1971 by the District Magistrate of Cooch Behar. Approval was sanctioned by the Govt. of West Bengal and the University of North Bengal on 24.12.1971 and 12.01.1972 respectively for the glorious start of the college from 1971-'72 academic session. At that time the student strength was 48 for Pre University and 38 for B.A. (Total enrollment being 86).

# F. Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes:

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 (hereafter referred to as NEP or Policy) recognizes that higher education plays an extremely important role in promoting human as well as societal well-being and in developing India as envisioned in its Constitution - ademocratic, just, socially conscious, cultured, and humane nation upholding liberty, equality, fraternity, and justice for all. It notes that "given the 21st-century requirements, quality higher education must aim to develop good, thoughtful, well-rounded, and creative individuals".

The NEP 2020 states, "Assessments of educational approaches in undergraduate education that integrate the humanities and arts with Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) have consistently shown positive learning outcomes, including increased creativity and innovation, critical thinking and higher-order thinking capacities, problem-solving abilities, teamwork, communication skills, more in-depth learning and mastery of curricula across fields, increases in social and moral awareness, etc., besides general engagement and enjoyment of learning"

Further, it also recommends that "the undergraduate degree will be of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple exit options within this period, with appropriate certifications, e.g., a UG certificate after completing 1 year in a discipline or field including vocational and professional areas, or a UG diploma after 2 years of study, or a Bachelor's degree after a 3-year programme. The 4-year multidisciplinary Bachelor's programme, however, shall be the preferred option since it allows the opportunity to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per the choices of the student".

### Transformative initiatives that have a bearing on the undergraduate education

- Undergraduate degree programmes of either 3 or 4-year duration, with multiple entry and exit points and re-entry options, with appropriate certifications such as:
- a UG certificate after completing 1 year (2 semesters) of study in the chosen fieldsof study,
- a UG diploma after 2 years (4 semesters) of study,
- a bachelor's degree after a 3-year (6 semesters) programme of study,
- a 4-year bachelor's degree (honours) after eight semesters programme of study. If the student completes a rigorous research project in their major area(s) of studyin the 4<sup>th</sup> year of a bachelor's degree (honours with research).
- The 4-year bachelor's degree programme is considered a preferred option since it

would provide the opportunity to experience the full range of holistic and multidisciplinary education in addition to a focus on the chosen major and minors as per the choices of the student.

#### **Curriculum Framework**

#### Main features of the New Curriculum Framework

The new curriculum framework will have the following features:

- i. Flexibility to move from one discipline of study to another;
- ii. Opportunity for learners to choose the courses of their interest in all disciplines;
- iii. Facilitating multiple entry and exit options with UG certificate/ UG diploma/ or degree depending upon the number of credits secured;
- iv. Flexibility for learners to move from one institution to another to enable them to have multi and/or interdisciplinary learning;
- v. Flexibility to switch to alternative modes of learning (offline, ODL, and Online learning, and hybrid modes of learning).

Regulations for **Academic Bank of Credit (ABC)(** <a href="https://www.abc.gov.in/">https://www.abc.gov.in/</a>) and guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exitare already in place to facilitate the implementation of the proposed "Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes".

**Definitions, Eligibility, and Duration of the Programme** 

### **Semester/Credits:**

- A semester comprises 90 working days and an academic year is divided into twosemesters.
- summer term is for eight weeks during summer vacation. Internship/apprenticeship/work-based vocational education and training can be carried out during the summer term, especially by students who wish to exit after two semesters or four semesters of study. Regular courses may also be offered during the summer on a fast-track mode to enable students to do additional courses or complete backlogs in coursework. The HEIs can decide on the courses to be offered in the summer term depending on the availability of faculty and the number of students.

### Major and Minor disciplines

- **Major discipline** is the discipline or subject of main focus and the degree will be awarded in that discipline. Students should secure the prescribed number of credits (about 50% oftotal credits) through core courses in the major discipline.
- Minor discipline helps a student to gain a broader understanding beyond the major discipline. For example, if a student pursuing an Economics major obtains a

minimum of 12 credits from a bunch of courses in Statistics, then the student will be awarded B.A. degree in Economics with a Minor in Statistics

### Awarding UG Certificate, UG Diploma, and Degrees

- ❖ UG Certificate: Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the first year. These students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- ❖ UG Diploma: Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 80 credits will be awarded the UG diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the second year. These students are allowed to re-enter within a period of three years and complete the degree programme within the maximum period of seven years.
- ❖ 3-year UG Degree: Students who wish to undergo a 3-year UG programme will be awarded UG Degree in the Major discipline after successful completion of three years, securing 120 credits and satisfying the minimum credit requirement.
- ❖ 4-year UG Degree (Honours): A four-year UG Honours degree in the major discipline will be awarded to those who complete a four-year degree programme with 160 credits and have satisfied the credit requirements.
- ❖ 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research): Students who secure 75% marks and above in the first six semesters and wish to undertake research at the undergraduate level can choose a research stream in the fourth year. They should do a research project or dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of the University/College. The research project/dissertation will be in the major discipline. The students, who secure 160 credits, including 12 credits from a research project/dissertation, are awarded UG Degree (Honours with Research).

### **♣** Infrastructure Requirement:

The Departments offering a 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research) must have the required infrastructure such as the library, access to journals, computer lab and software, laboratory facilities to carry out experimental research work, and at *least two permanent faculty members who are recognized as Ph.D. supervisors*. The Departments already recognized for conducting the Ph.D. programme may conduct a 4-year UG Degree (Honours with Research) without obtaining anyapproval from the affiliating University.

### **UG Degree Programmes with Single Major:**

A student has to secure a minimum of 50% credits from the major discipline for the 3-year/4-year UG degree to be awarded a single major. For example, in a 3-year UG programme, if the total number of credits to be earned is 120, a student of Physics with a minimum of 60 credits will be awarded a B.Sc. in Physics with a single major. Similarly, in a 4-year UG programme, if the total number of credits to be earned is 160,

a student of Physics with a minimum of 80 credits will be awarded a B.Sc. (Hons./Hon. With Research) in Physics in a 4-year UG programme with single major.

### **Interdisciplinary UG Programmes:**

The credits for core courses shall be distributed among the constituent disciplines/subjects so as to get core competence in the interdisciplinary programme. For example, a degree in Econometrics requires courses in economics, statistics, and mathematics. The total credits to core courses shall be distributed so that the student gets full competence in Econometrics upon completion of the programme.

The degree for such students will be awarded as B.Sc. in Econometrics for a 3-year UG programme or B.Sc. (Honours) / B.Sc. (Honours with Research) in Econometrics for a 4-year UG programme.

### **Multidisciplinary UG Programmes:**

In the case of students pursuing a multidisciplinary programme of study, the credits to core courses will be distributed among the broad disciplines such as Life sciences, Physical Sciences, Mathematical and Computer Sciences, Data Analysis, Social Sciences, Humanities, etc.,

For example, a student whoopts for a UG program in Life sciences will have the total credits to core courses distributed across Botany, Zoology and Human biology disciplines. The degree will be awarded as B.Sc. in Life Sciences for a 3-year programme and B.Sc. (Honours) in Life Sciences or B.Sc. (Honours with Research) for a 4-year programme without or with a research component respectively.

The statutory bodies of the Universities and Colleges such as the Board of Studies and Academic Council will decide on the list of courses under major category and credit distribution for double major, interdisciplinary and multidisciplinary programmes.

• 16 Major papers (2 in 1st year, 4 in 2nd year, 6 in 3rd year, 4 in 4th year) & additional 3 Major papers, only for those who will not take Research paper in 4th year.

Thus, 4Year UG Degree with Research will have 16 Major subjects & 4Year UG Degree without Research will have 19 Major subjects

- ➤ MINOR= Minor (MINOR)-To gain a broader understanding beyond the major discipline.
- > Students need to choose any two Minor Discipline/Subjects, each comprising of 3 papers(Two Minors in 1 year, two in 2nd Year and two in 4th Year)
- Each Minor discipline will have 3 papers, follow the below mentioned minor subject combinations:

### **Minor Subject combination for Science Discipline:**

- 1. **Chemistry (Major):-** Minors-(i) Mathematics (1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> semester) (ii) Physics or Computer Science (3rd, 4th and 8th semester)

For each Discipline there will be one MDC.
- ➤ ABILITY ENHANCEMENT COURSES= AEC (two AEC papers; one in 1" Semester & one in 4th Semester)- language focused on language and communication skills
- ➤ Modern English Language (MIL)-Bengali or Hindi or Sanskrit or Alternative English in 1 Semester & Basics in English in 4th Semester
- ➤ SKILL ENHANCEMENT COURSES-SEC (three SEC courses; each SEC subject will have 3 papers, each in 1st, 2nd and 3rd semester) these courses are aimed at imparting practical skills, hands-on training, soft skills, etc., to enhance the employability of students. ### ➤ INTERNSHIP (INTRN): (To be carried out at 2nd semester)

A course requiring students to participate in a professional activity or work experience, or cooperative education activity with an entity external to the education institution, normally under the supervision of an expert of the given external entity. A key aspect of internship is induction into actual work situations. All students will also undergo internships in a firm, industry, or organization or training in labs with faculty and researchers in their own or other HEls/research institutions during the summer term. NSS activities (apart from Regular/ Special NSS activities) may also be considered in the Internship during summer term.

> RESEARCH PROJECT/DISSERTATION=RESEARCH (2 Research papers, one at each 7th and 8th semester)

Students who secure 75% marks and above in the First 6 semesters and wish to undertake research at the UG level can choose a Research stream in the 4th year. Students need to carry out dissertation under the guidance of a faculty member of University/College.

- Selection of Major or Minor courses depends on the availability that particular course has been taught in the respective colleges.
- <u>Introduction of Major or Minor courses by the college are subject to approval by the University followed by WB Council of Higher Education.</u>
- The College is facilitated by the NCC "B" and "C" Certificate Courses under the both 13 Bengal Bn NCC Unit & 7 Bengal Bn NCC Unit, Cooch Behar under the guidance of Lt. Dr. Bhupen Barman & Captain Sayoni Biswas, trained ANOs.

### UNIVERSITY GUIDELINES FOR 4-YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME ADMISSION FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION OF 2023 – 2024

The online Admission to and Commencement of 1<sup>st</sup> Semester 4-year UG Programme and Self-Financed courses for the Academic Session **2023-2024**, of the Colleges affiliated to Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University will be held as per the below mentioned schedule:

- 1. Date of opening of Online Portal for Application for UG Courses: 01.07.2023
- 2. Completion of Application in the Online Portal for UG Courses by: 15.07.2023
- 3. Publication of Merit Lists in UG Courses by: 20.07.2023
- 4. Completion of Admission at the UG Courses by: 31.07.2023
- 5. Start of 1st Semester of UG Courses on: 01.08.2023
- 6. Last date of Registration: will be notified in due course
- 7. Whenever a student is admitted to a College or the University for the first time he/she shall forward an application for Registration in prescribed form to the Registrar through the Principal unless his name has already been so registered. Every such application shall be submitted within one month of the last date of admission of the student to the College or the University.
- 8. Last date of submission of Registration Forms from the college to the Office of the Registrar will be notified in due course (All information—and guidelines, related to filling—in and submission of Registration Forms will be informed to the Principals / Vice-Principal/Teachers-in-Charge / Officers-in-Charge of all Degree Colleges affiliated to the Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University by the Registrar, Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University accordingly).
- i) Attention of the Colleges is also drawn to the following points:
- a. Intake (in the number) of students in 4-year UG Programme shall not exceed the specified number as approved by the Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University from time to time. In case of any violation, the University shall take appropriate action as deemed fit. Registrations, of all students who have been admitted, exceeding the approved intake of the University shall be automatically cancelled in order of their dates of admission to the respective Colleges.
- b. No Admission shall take place after the Last date of Admission as per this notification.

Registration of candidates who have been admitted after the last date of admission shall be automatically cancelled. Requests for extension of the Last date of Admission after the expiry date shall not be entertained by the University under any circumstances.

ii) Eligibility for Admission: Students who have passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) conducted by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education (W.B.C.H.S.E.) after a period of 12 years study or any other equivalent (10+2) pattern of examination conducted by the I.S.C. or C.B.S.E. or any other Board recognized as equivalent by the Cooch Behar Panchanan Barma University, provided the student has passed in at least four subjects with English as Compulsory Subject.



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# UNIVERSITY GUIDELINES FOR 4-YEAR UNDER GRADUATE PROGRAMME ADMISSION FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION OF 2023 – 2024

For all laboratory-based subjects, the student must have passed in that subject at 10+2 level, if that subject exists in the HS subjects list, or equivalent subject if it does not exist in the HS list of subjects, as per existing admission guidelines.

A student will be allowed to take admission in the Major Course if he/she/transgender has passed in at least four (04) subjects with English as compulsory subject in the Higher Secondary [10+2] Examination held by the West Bengal Council of Higher Secondary Education or any other Examination which is recognized by the University as equivalent thereto.

Admission will be on merit and availability of seats, provided that for SC/ST Candidates, the minimum marks for eligibility will be as per rules of the State Government.

A candidate will be allowed to take up any Major Subject in **4-year UG Programme**, if he/she/transgender has passed in the corresponding subject (s) at the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) recognized as equivalent by the University.

#### However:

- a) A candidate will be allowed to take up Sociology, Education, Physical Education, BBA or BBM if he/she/transgender has passed in the previous qualifying examination of any stream.
- b) A candidate will be allowed to take up Commerce. if he/she/transgender has studied Science subjects along with Mathematics in the previous qualifying exams.
- c) A candidate will be allowed to take up Physics Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Chemistry along with Physics and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- d) A candidate will be allowed to take up Chemistry Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics and Physics along with Chemistry and other subject as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- e) A candidate will be allowed to take up Botany/Zoology Subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biology at the qualifying examination.
- f) A candidate will be allowed to take up Physiology subject if he/she/transgender has passed in Biological Science and Chemistry at the qualifying examination.
- g) A candidate will be allowed to take up Computer Science Subject if he/she/ transgender has passed in Mathematics at the qualifying examination.
- h) A candidate will be allowed to take up Economics as if he/she/transgender has passed in Mathematics or Applied Mathematics or Business Economics including Business Mathematics, and other subjects as prescribed at the qualifying examination.
- i) No student other than those of Science stream and Economics/Geography of Arts stream will be allowed to take Science subjects as Minor Subjects.
- j) A candidate pursuing Major in a subject will not be allowed to take up the same subject as Minor.

- k) A candidate pursuing Major in a Language subject will be allowed to take another Language subject as a Minor Subject.
- 1) While taking Major & Minor subjects, availability of the said subjects in the concerned Colleges will be taken into cognizance.

### Merit calculation:

Admission to all Course will be based strictly on merit. Merit shall be calculated as per the following formula.

Merit= (2S+T)/6

T = Aggregate = marks obtained in English + marks obtained in the subject opted for Major + best marks of other two subjects

[Excluding the subject opted for Major and English].

S= marks obtained in the subject opted for Major.

If the candidate does not have the specific subject opted for Major in his / her previous Course, the procedure for Merit Calculation will be as follows,

Merit = $T_1/4$ 

T<sub>1</sub>=marks obtained in English+ best of other three subjects

Tie Break rule: If more than one candidate score same merit point, preference will be given to the one who has scored higher marks in the subject (selected subject for 4-year UG Programme), in this way, if more than one candidate have same merit point and same marks in the subject; preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in the (10+2)/HS level Examination considering best five subjects, if more candidates have same merit points and same marks in the (10+2)/HS level Examination; preference will be given to the candidate who has scored higher marks in the 10th/Madhyamik level Examination.

A candidate failed in a particular subject in 10+2 or its equivalent examination will not be considered for admission in 4-year UG Programme for that particular subject.

A candidate failed in either theory or practical subject in 10+2 or its equivalent examination will not be considered for taking 4-year UG Programme in that particular major subject.

Note: A candidate will be allowed to pursue a maximum of Three Year under a Major Course if he/she/transgender have passed the qualifying Examination in Vocational Stream subjects.
